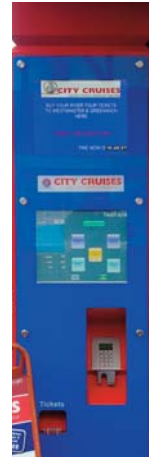


CITY CRUISES

The kiosks are located at City Cruises sales offices at Tower Pier and the Embankment at Westminster.
